A RESOLUTION

Consenting to and confirming the nomination of Mr. Daniel K. Kephas to serve as a member of the Kosrae Broadcast Authority Board of Directors.

1 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 12 of Article V of the Kosrae State Constitution, the
2 Governor has the constitutional authority to appoint members comprising State Boards,
3 Authority, Commissions or Agencies with the advice and consent of the Legislature; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Section 7.201 of Title 7 of the Kosrae State Code established the Kosrae
5 Broadcast Authority; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Section 7.202 of Title 7 of the Kosrae State Code, the Authority is directed
7 by a Board of five members who serve terms of two years. Until appointment of a majority of the
8 board the Authority's affairs are managed by its highest-ranking staff person; and

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Governor's Message dated October 29, 2024 is a nomination
10 upon Mr. Daniel K. Kephas replacing Mr. Kun A. Phillip, as the representation for Malem in the
11 board composition; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Daniel K. Kephas is born and raised in Malem and is currently residing
13 in Malem. Mr. Kephas is well – aware of his nomination and has expressed his interest in
14 becoming a board member for Kosrae Broadcast Authority; **NOW AND THEREFORE**

15 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the 13th Kosrae State Legislature, during its Fourteenth Special
16 Session, November 2024, hereby consents to and confirms the nomination of Mr. Daniel K.
17 Kephas to serve as a member of the Kosrae Broadcast Authority Board of Directors; and
