#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$2,731,984 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$1,453,762\_from the State Revenue Fund (funding the first quarter of fiscal year 2024); the sum of \$1,315,432\_from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$866,259\_from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024 for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE
