A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 18.601 of Title 18 of the Kosrae State Code by modifying the salary schedule of Kosrae State Government Public Service System_employees to include a forty-five percent (45%) salary increase to its amounts and to award the same to all other State Government employees; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

- Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this act is to amend section 18.601 of Title 18
- of the Kosrae State Code to include a forty-five percent (45%) salary increase to its
- amounts and to award the same increase to all other State Government employees.
- Section 2. Amendment. Title 18, Chapter 6, Section 18.601 of the Kosrae State
- Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "Chapter 6. Compensation.
- Section 18.601. Salary schedule.
- (1) There shall be a single salary schedule for all employees and positions in the
- 9 public service. The Director shall assign each class of positions to an appropriate salary
- level of such schedule based on the position classification plan adopted by the Oversight
- 11 Board.
- (2) Subsequent changes to the salary schedule contained herein by way of increase
- or reduction in authorized pay-period hours may be made by regulation promulgated by
- the Oversight Board. (3) The salary of each public service position is pursuant to lawful
- classification by step and pay level of the position and to the base salary schedule of

6	biweekly salary rate appearing in the following table. Step increases are to be used only							
17	for the determination of salary for new hires and reallocations in order to determine the							
18	beginning salary of the new hire or the reallocated position. The use of Steps is not a							
19	means of promotion within this public service system, and are to be used only to							
20	determine the salary of an individual promoted to another pay level to insure a loss of pay							
21	does not occur on promotion.
