Section 1. <u>Purpose</u> . The purpose of this act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by

Section 2. Section 5.201 of Title 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(i) coordinates economic planning, including the Government's
adherence to the overall Economic Development Plan.
(6) The Office of the Attorney General
(a) enforces State penal laws, delegating enforcement to a department in
its discretion;
(b) oversees Government compliance with law;
(c) provides legal advice and representation to the Executive, including
the collection of outstanding reimbursements and revenues;
(d) provides legal advice and representation to other components of
Government when directed by the Governor; and
(e) regulates the use of roads by motor vehicles; and
(f) appoints persons as deputies for the enforcement of general or
specific laws, according to criteria established by the Attorney
General.
