A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the Kosrae State Code by amending and repealing certain sections of Chapter 14 of Title 12, by replacing a new alcoholic drink purchasing requirement; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

- Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by amending Section 12.1401 of Title 12, to eliminate the drinking permit requirement.
- Section 2. Amendment. Title 12, Section 12.1401 of the Kosrae State Code is
- 4 hereby amended as follows:
- "Section 12.1401. Sales license. By regulation which may include the definition of
- 6 terms, the Office of the Attorney General provides for the sale of alcoholic drink by
- issuance of a sales license, and by monitoring compliance with license requirements.
- Upon request a person shows a license to Office of Attorney General personnel."
- Section 3. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by
- amending Section 12.1402 of Title 12, to eliminate the drinking permit requirement.
- Section 4. Amendment. Title 12, Section 12.1402 of the Kosrae State Code is
- 12 hereby amended as follows:
- "Section 12.1402. Seller's duty. Before selling alcoholic drinks, a person
- determines whether the buyer has the requisite proof of age."
