The sum of \$9,664,963, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$3,289,825, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund; and the sum of \$1,189,228, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United States Grant Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.
